## Fish in Rivers Factsheet

## WRBD

**Cornamona River Catchment** 

The Cornamona River catchment is located within the Western River Basin District and covers an area of approximately 28km<sup>2</sup>. The Cornamona River rises on Lugnabrick Mountain close to the north-western side of Lough Corrib Upper and flows in a south-easterly direction joining the lake, just east of Cornamona Village, Co. Galway. Geology is comprised of sandstone and schist. The primary land use types include Atlantic blanket bog and forestry, with areas of agriculture (rough grazing), encountered in the

lower reaches and along the main channel. Significant pockets of land along the main channel of this river fall within the Lough Corrib Special Area of Conservation.

Sixteen sites were surveyed on the Cornamona River catchment between the 20<sup>th</sup> of August and 4<sup>th</sup> of September 2018.




Fig 1. Map of Cornamona River Catchment electrofishing survey sites, 2018





## Summary

Five fish species were recorded at sixteen sites surveyed on the Cornamona River Catchment in 2018. Brown trout was the most abundant species captured. Salmon were recorded at twelve out of sixteen sites fished. Four age classes of brown trout 0+, 1+, 2+ & 3+ were present and ranged in length from 3.5 to 21.5cm. Three age classes of salmon 0+, 1+ and 2+ (with 0+ being the most popular cohort) were present across the catchment. Salmon ranged in length from 3 to 12.1cm. One pike measuring 11.6cm in length was recorded at site 12. Perch were recorded at site 11 and 16 and ranged in length from 5.2 to 7.1cm. Minnow were recorded at site 11 only.

Thirteen sites (87%) were assigned a fish ecological status of Good while three achieved Moderate or Poor status.
