

Waterford City and County Trout Anglers Development Project

Equipment Project

Waterford City & County Trout Anglers, formed in 1983. The club manages two lakes in Waterford which are available for fly fishing by permit for both brown and rainbow trout all year round. These lakes are Knockaderry Reservoir and Carrigavantry Reservoir. The Club has carried out a lot of development on the lakes over the years.

The project involved the purchase of three new boats that will pass the EU Recreational Craft Directive standard (CE CERTIFICATION). The purchase of these boats allowed the Waterford City and County Trout Development Association provide local and visiting anglers the opportunity to experience excellent trout angling on both Knockaderry Reservoir and Carrigavantry Reservoir in a modern safe boat.

For reasons of safety and security there was a need to erect safety/security fencing enclosing the waterfront and surrounding the container, the canteen, the toilet and the Wheelyboat harbour on the shore of Knockaderry Lake. The total project cost the club €14,455 of which the NSAD funded €9,850.
