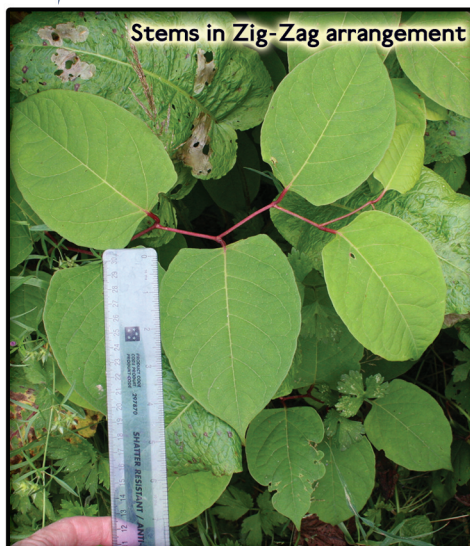
Japanese Knotweed

Small bright green leaves (≤ 17 cm) with flat bases and strongly pointed tips



Stems in Zig-Zag arrangement



Red / Purple mottled stems, (occasionally red)



Stems hollow in cross-section



Creamy white to greenish white flowers, arranged in long branched clusters
